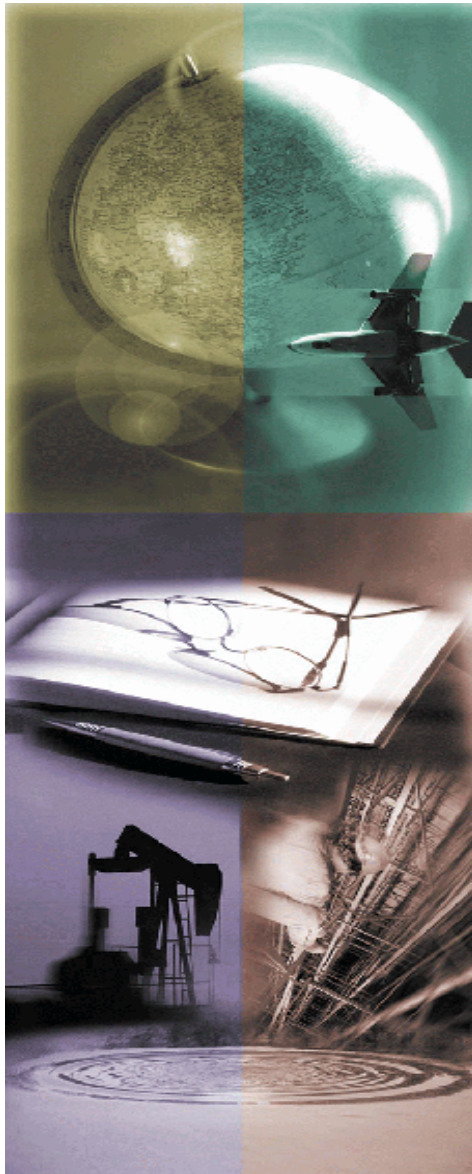

3 Types Of Tickets

- 1) Pre-set tickets**
- 2) Failure to appear tickets or informations**
- 3) Execution (money only) tickets or time pay orders**

1) Pre-set tickets, which are tickets that have a dollar amount listed on the ticket will be handled by the City & Court cashiers. The cashiers will be allowed to waive any late charges or warrant fees, but only if the ticket is paid in a single lump sum during the 3 week amnesty period.

2) Failure to appear cases fall into 2 categories: The first category is any ticket that had the word 'Court' written in on the face of the ticket for which a person failed to appear. The second category is any case in which a person was arrested and then failed to show up for Court.

In these cases, a defendant will come to Court, appear in front of the Judge and/or have a chance to discuss their case(s) with the Prosecutor, at which point recommendations may be made for finances and costs that will not include late fees or warrant fees for coming in. The Court will then work out a final solution on each case just as they normally would.

3) 'Failure to pay warrants' involves cases where the Court ordered a certain amount of money to be paid that, for some reason, was not paid. These matters will be handled by the

Court exclusively. The rules are that any defendant, to qualify, must put down at least 25% of the outstanding balance, with no more than 90 days to pay the balance.

During this amnesty period, there are no exceptions to these rules.
